
Arts/Cinema/Creative/Literature/Performing - Debbe Mervine

Here is an authentic colonial recipe for Pumpkin Soup, only modified for canned pumpkin puree. It is delicious and does not taste like pumpkin pie. Enjoy!

PUMPKIN SOUP- Debbe Mervine

Serves 6

- 3 Tbsp butter
- 1 lg Onion, chopped
- 2 Cups Canned Pumpkin
- 1 Tsp Salt
- 1 Tsp Sugar
- 1/4 Tsp Nutmeg
- 1/4. Tsp Pepper
- 3 Cups Chicken Broth
- 1/2 Cup Light Cream



Note 1: I use Campbell's condensed Chicken Broth, reconstituted. One can = 21 oz. The best flavor!

Note 2: If taking the soup on the road, don't add the broth & cream til after you arrive. Saves sloshing in the car.

Note 3: If doubled, the large can of pumpkin is perfect. Enjoy!
