There is an App called Adobe Scan available for iPhones or in an Android version. It allows you to take a picture of a receipt or a document and turn it into a PDF. The PDF can be more than one page. Once you have created the PDF, you can text, or e-mail the PDF right from your phone. A PDF is often much easier to download and print (hint! hint!) than a jpg file when you submit a reimbursement request.

I have also used this app while working from home (in lieu of having a fax machine) when someone is requesting a signed document be sent to them. I have probably used the app at least once a week since someone showed it to me.

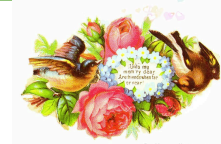

This summer, we will be learning more about ways we can help the **New Jersey Children's Alliance**, our Special State Project. Stay tuned!

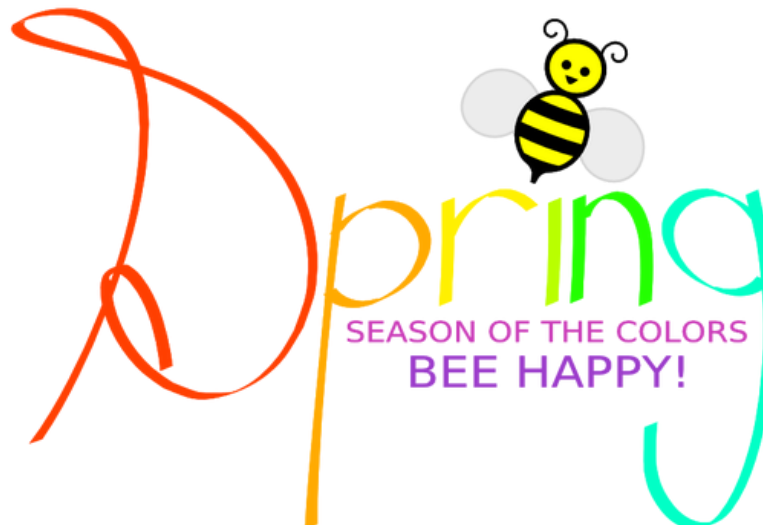

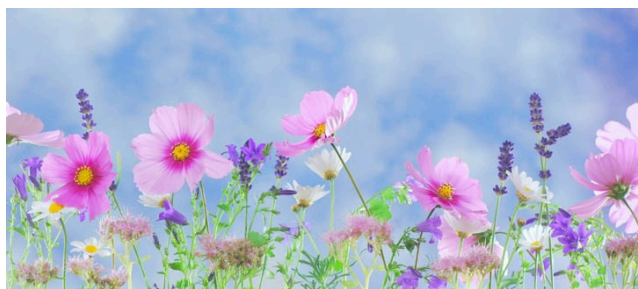
